SUBJECT: RESOLUTION OF SAFETY CONCERN: 96-080  
BUILDING INDOCTRINATION

The Joint Company/Union Safety Committee (JCUSC) investigated the subject safety concern with the following results:

Subcontractors performed work in Building 460 without receiving a building indoctrination or without having a trained and qualified escort assigned to them, thus violating HSP10.2

DynCorp of Colorado, Inc., who was assigned the responsibility of Building 460 after this safety concern was initiated, has provided the JCUSC with their response. John Cissell, Facility Operations, and Tim Cobb, 460 Building Manager, agreed that all vendors performing work in Building 460 will be given a building indoctrination prior to beginning work. In addition, the JCUSC investigators contacted J. O. Cisneros, Radiological Engineering, for Building 460. Mr. Cisneros notified the JCUSC that the office equipment in question was removed from Building 460 in accordance with ROI 3.02 and HSP18.10

With the above actions, the JCUSC considers this safety concern adequately resolved.

Changes to this agreement cannot be made without concurrence by the JCUSC. If you have additional problems with this concern, the resolution, or the implementation of the corrective actions, please contact the JCUSC. Thank you for participating in the safety concern process.
